- 2. Print the form using the 'Print Form' button.

- 4. Sign the form in Section 4, a digital signature is **not** acceptable.
- 5. Scan and email the signed appeal form, the document from Section 3 and any supporting documents to lawstudentservices@marquette.edu by the deadline in the Academic Censure notification you received. The email MUST be sent from your Marquette email account.
